## Construction Update

Demolition, has progressed well across the project and Keltbray have now handed over control of the site to Sir Robert McAlpine as our Principal Contractor.

Sir Robert McAlpine is a leading UK building and civil engineering company, who work to the highest standards of health and safety. They are committed to quality and to fulfilling their responsibilities to the communities and environments in which they operate. Sir Robert McAlpine have a long history in the area, as for many years prior to our demolition, Yorkshire House on Grosvenor Crescent housed their London & South East regional head office.

Key Items Include:

- No road closures or traffic diversions are planned during September.
- BT & Colt will be decommissioning and removing redundant cable boxes from the pavements on Grosvenor Place and Grosvenor Crescent during September, and we will work with them to keep pavements open during this time.
