Construction Update

The welfare gantry on Grosvenor Place has been wrapped in Monoflex.

Construction of the four lift & stair cores is continuing with most of this work being completed by Christmas.

The vehicle traffic route through the site will commence in January 2019 as the main excavation works commence; vehicles will enter site via Halkin Street and exit via Grosvenor Crescent.

Works to the superstructure are underway with the excavation commencing in November.

The Tower cranes will be moved from their current location to the tops of the four cores between January and March 2019. This will include weekend road closures of both Halkin Street and Grosvenor Crescent.) We will provide more detailed updates in the New Year

A protection gantry along Grosvenor Place (south end) will be installed once the superstructure works progress in this area. This will likely happen in mid-January we will provide more detailed updates in the New Year.

The most recent Construction Liaison Group (CLG) meeting was held in September and was well attended by local resident and business groups. The next CLG meeting is scheduled for Tuesday 11th December. For more information please contact Soundings.
