Construction Update

Vehicle Access

Egress route through the site remains in use; vehicles use Halkin Street for access and Grosvenor Crescent for egress. Excavation works are well underway and will continue throughout this year; the Superstructure continues to rise and has now reached its highest point in quadrant B. This Milestone was marked by a ceremony on site on June 19th. Final completion of the whole frame is due by the end of August. All tower cranes now sit on top of the lift cores. Façade works have commenced on Halkin Street and the protection gantry on Grosvenor Place is operational.

Key Information

There will be possible external works in Belgravia by UKPN to bring additional power to the new development. This will be carried out over the next 6 months in small sections.

Sewer connections will start underground in Halkin Street and Grosvenor Crescent. This will not affect either roads or footpaths.

No road closures are planned over the next two months, although Forbes House plan one for the weekend of 20th/21st July.

The motorcycle bay on Grosvenor Crescent by the Santander bike stand will be closed once the adjacent site access is re-opened. The bike stand will remain open for the duration of our works.
